The North West Parachute Centre Limited has a proud history of aiding people to complete a sponsored parachute jump. You can do a Solo or Tandem Skydive for charity.



How to go about skydiving for charity

Pick the skydiving course most suited to you or your group ensuring you meet all age, weight and medical criteria. Choose the charity you want to Skydive for - it's entirely up to you! You will need to raise a minimum amount of sponsorship money in order for you to Skydive free (£380 for a Static-Line Solo Jump and £440.00 for the Tandem Skydive) and the charity will receive 50%. In addition to this, every extra pound that you raise over the minimum goes directly to the charity, so try to raise as much money as you can!

Once you have collect the deposit of £50.00, forward it together with the application form to the North West Parachute Centre Limited, who will acknowledge receipt of your booking. Continue collecting the sponsorship monies, as the remainder of the course balance, is due on the day of the course. **Remember to bring this with you!** Having jumped, collect the remaining sponsorship monies and forward it to your chosen charity. The centre can provide you with sponsor forms or you may wish to use those provided by the charity of your choice.

Warning! Sport Parachuting is classified as a dangerous adventure sport. There is a risk whether slight, medium or even fatal attached to a parachute jump. Despite rigorous training and adherence to safety standards, a risk still remains. Do not take part in Skydiving or Sport Parachuting if you are not willing to accept the risks.
